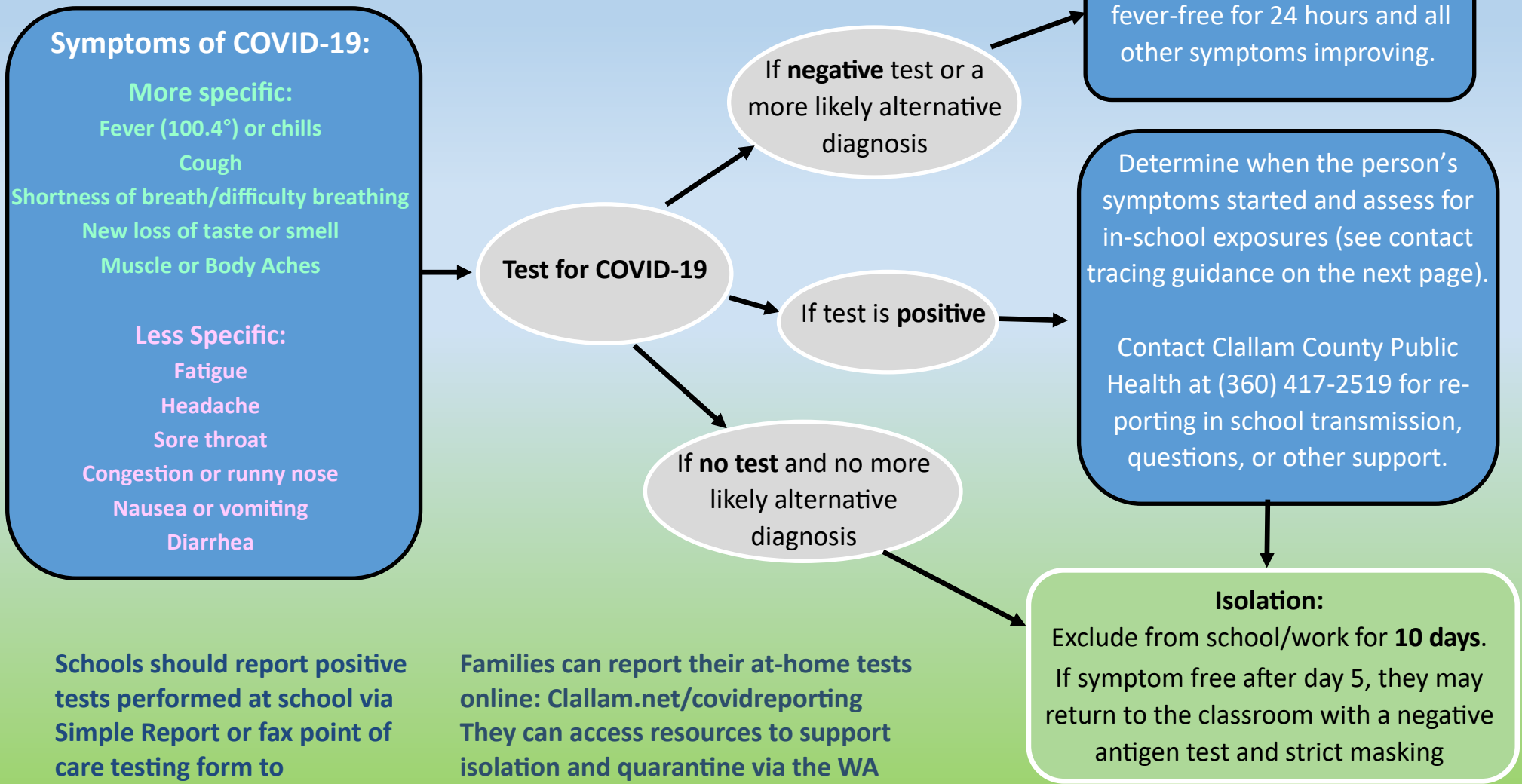


# COVID-19 Return to School Flow Chart

## How to Care for Students/Staff Exposed to COVID-19

Is this person's **vaccine status** up-to-date? (See below.)

Was the exposure on school grounds?

Can continue work/school uninterrupted. Testing is recommended 5 days after exposure. Masking is recommended for 10 days after exposure.

Notify all exposed individuals within 48 hours.

Was this a household exposure (parent/sibling positive)?

**Vaccine Status** is up-to-date if you have received all doses in the primary series and one booster when eligible.

**Determining Exposure:** In an unmasked indoor setting, a person is considered exposed to COVID-19 if they were: in the same classroom, rode the same bus, sat at the same lunch table, played indoor sports, or participated in extracurricular activities with a positive individual during their infectious period.

**Asymptomatic individuals who have recovered** from COVID-19 infection are exempt from COVID-19 testing and quarantine for 90 days.

Exposed individuals may continue to attend work/school. Offer testing 5 days after exposure. Masking is recommended for 10 days after exposure.

If 3 or more positive cases in a given setting (sports team, classroom, etc.) within a 7 day period.

**Begin Test-To-Stay:**  
If asymptomatic:

- May continue to attend work/school.
- Must wear a mask for the next 10 days.
- Test 2 times weekly for the next 7 days.
- If unable to wear a mask, quarantine 10 days.
