ACT PREP CLASS – Oct 14 and March 24 (tentative)

This is a test preparation course offered through Doorway to College. Students will learn and practice test taking strategies for each subtest. Students will learn how to use the calculator to maximize math scores and will receive study guides. Fee will be \$110.00.

SAT I TEST: This test is offered at Rock Bridge High School. Please see www.collegeboard.org for test dates and info.

PSAT – OCT 12 (during the school day)

The PSAT is the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test. It measures verbal and math reasoning abilities important for doing college work and helps students improve their test-taking strategies before taking the SAT. This test is used to determine eligibility for the National Merit Scholarship program. You MUST sign up in the guidance office to take this test. This is a junior level test; however, sophomores are encouraged to take it also.

FINANCIAL AID WORKSHOP – TBD

The Financial Aid Workshop will be held in the Commons at Boonville High School. A financial aid advisor will explain the types of aid and the process of applying for financial aid.

FAFSA FRENZY – October 16, 2:00 to 4:00

Seniors have the opportunity to complete the online Free Application for Financial Aid with assistance from college financial aid advisors.

ARMED SERVICES VOCATIONAL APTITUDE BATTERY (ASVAB) – NOV 18

The ASVAB will be given to all sophomores, juniors, and seniors who are interested in the military after graduation. Used for career information and shows aptitude in areas of math, science, English, mechanics, and shop.

ACCUPLACER – JAN 10; also given at State Fair Community College, Sedalia and Boonville Campuses

The Accuplacer is a computerized test that helps your college evaluate your skills and place you into appropriate courses. Accuplacer tests students in math, reading, and writing. You will receive your score immediately upon completion of testing. The Accuplacer will be given to ALL Juniors in January. You can also call the Boonville State Fair campus to schedule a testing session (882-3090).
