GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students must earn 24 credits for graduation. A student can earn a maximum of 7 credits per year. Credit is earned on a semester basis. There are 2 semesters per school year. A course that meets for 53 minutes a day, 5 days a week for 1 semester (approx. 18 weeks) earns 1/2 credit. School is in session 165 days a year.
