Summer reading is an opportunity for you to practice the comprehension, analytical, and note-taking skills learned throughout the year while reading a thought-provoking and enjoyable book. **The selected book that all 7th graders will be reading is *Woods Runner* by Gary Paulson.**

Woods Runner is the story of 13-year-old Samuel who is growing up during the Revolutionary War in 1776. While out hunting one day, Samuel's house is burnt down by British soldiers and, when he returns to the ashes, learns that his parents have been taken. The novel follows Samuel's long journey to find and rescue his parents. While reading and taking notes, keep the theme of courage and wisdom through life's journey in mind. This text was selected to provide a common foundation and reference for your 7th grade year. Keep in mind that this assignment is a chance for you to put your best foot forward!

In conjunction with this reading, scholars will be practicing their annotation skills by actively taking notes on their reading using either a separate notebook or sticky notes. Students will have no additional assignment for the summer beyond reading and taking notes on *Woods Runner*. These notes will then be used as a resource on their **first test grade** of their 7th grade year which will be happening in their **Humanities A Class the second week of school.**
