## **Open house will start in the gym for Station 1.**

**Station 1 Class Lists and Transportation:** In the gym, you will find out your child's homeroom teacher's name and sign up for transportation. Download the app for your phone and use the code from your child's teacher to access.

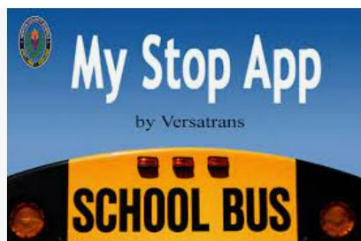
## School Messenger
