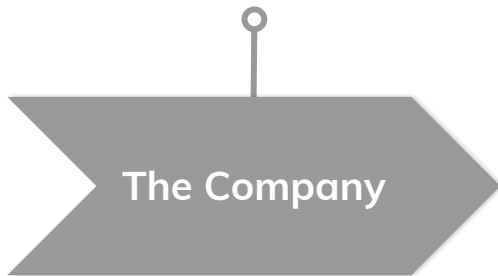

Getting Started

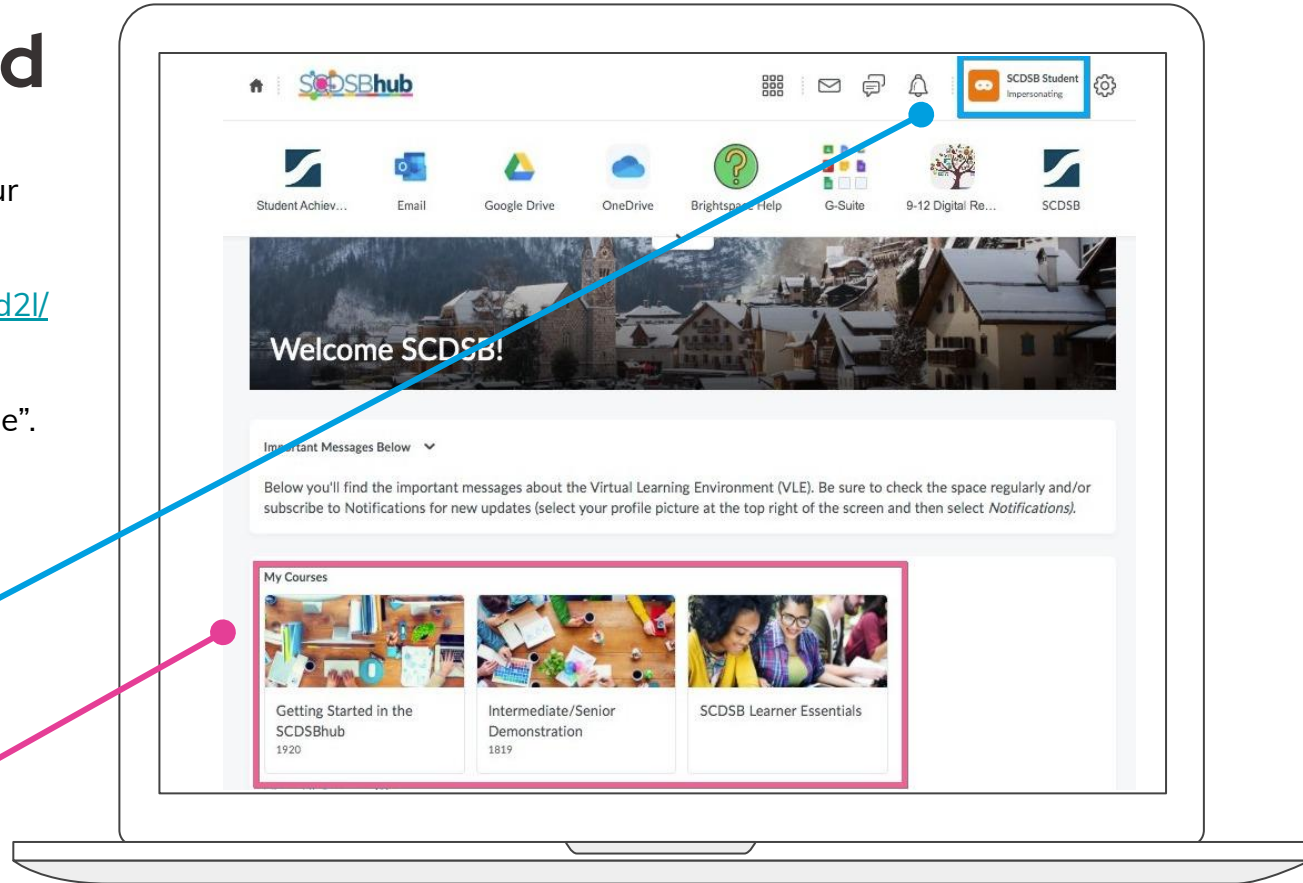
Log into the SCDSBhub using your SCDSB username and password.

Common Tools in the SCDSBhub

Activity Feed or News Feed



Purpose:

Tool(s) that allow educators to share announcements, activities and materials with students on the course homepage.

Content



Purpose:

Where you can find the lesson content and materials that have been shared by the educator.

Dropbox (AKA Assignments)



Purpose:

Submission folders and assignment due dates are found here.

Portfolio



Purpose:

Documentation tool to collect evidence of student learning.
