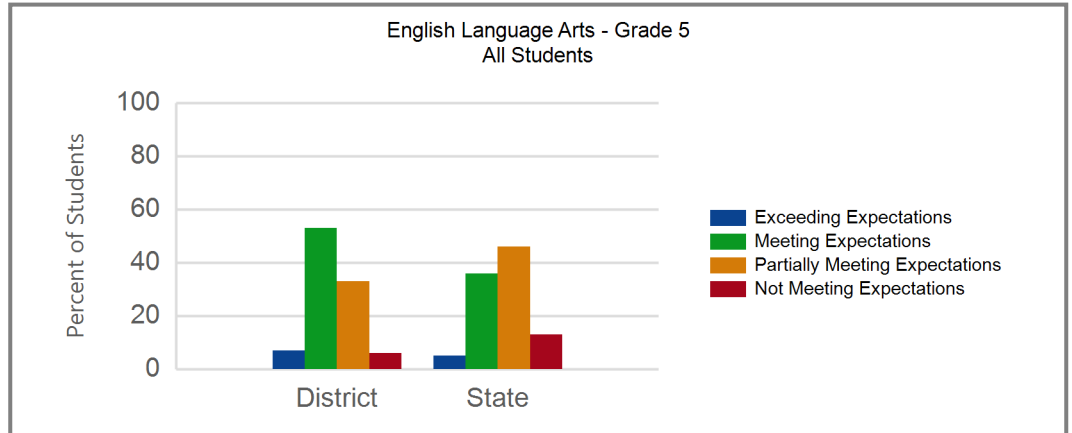

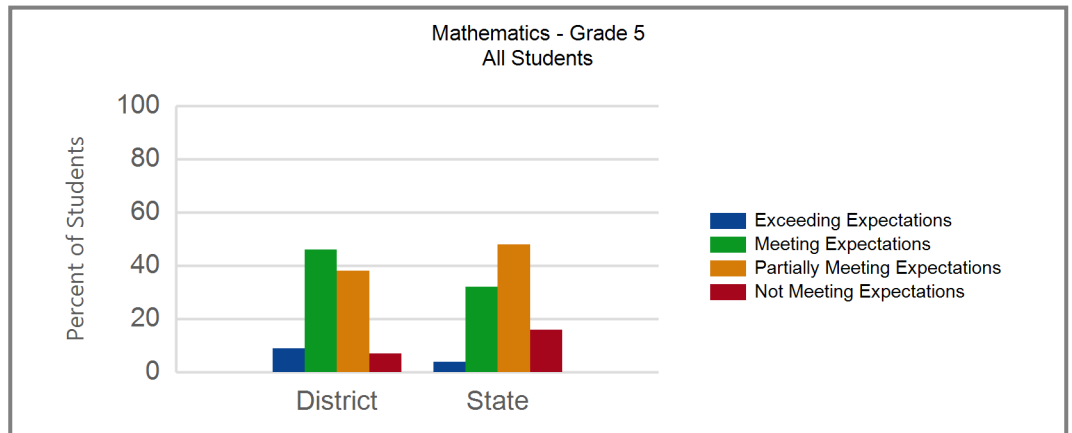

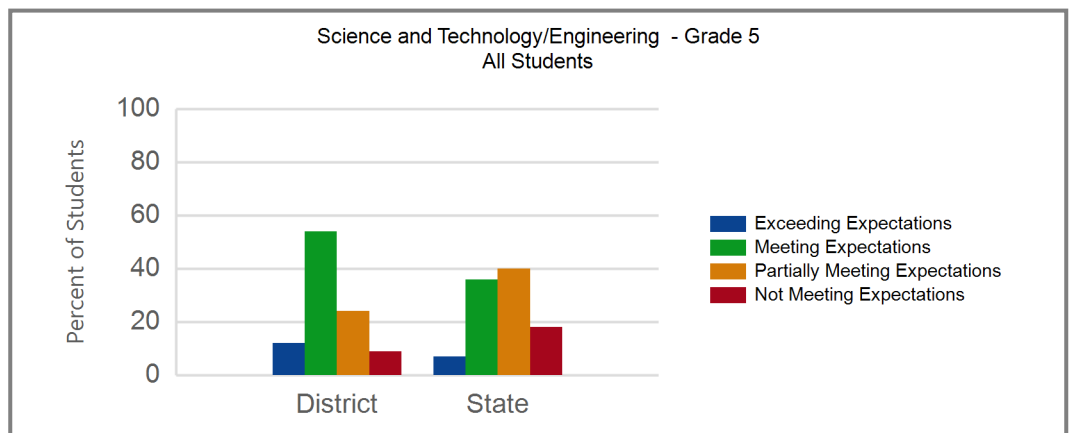

Low Income (2022 to present) indicates students participating in one or more of the following state-administered programs: the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP); the Transitional Assistance for Families with Dependent Children (TAFDC); the Department of Children and Families' (DCF) foster care program; expanded MassHealth (Medicaid) up to 185% of the federal poverty level; students identified by districts as homeless; and students the district confirmed had met the low-income criteria through the supplemental process and collected the required supporting documentation.
