<p>Our goal is always to keep our school buildings open. However, Suffolk Public Schools will be prepared to transition students in and out of in-person learning for quarantine related reasons due to COVID-19.</p> <p>In the event of a classroom, school, or division level closure, detailed information will be communicated to parents/students via multiple platforms to include Canvas announcements, school websites, School Messenger, and/or division/school social media accounts, depending on the level of closure.</p>	<p>In the event of a classroom closure, all students and staff in the impacted class will transition to virtual learning for that class until the class can reopen. All impacted students will access synchronous and/or asynchronous instruction and assignments through Canvas.</p> <p>In the event of a school or division closure, all students will access synchronous and asynchronous instruction, and their assignments via Canvas.</p>	<p>Elementary schedules will include times for Morning Meeting, Language Arts, Math, Science/Social Studies, Resource, lunch and recess following the regular school schedule (with the addition of brain breaks from screen time as needed).</p>	<p>Impacted elementary students will receive synchronous and asynchronous instruction. Synchronous instruction will occur through Zoom, Google Meet, and/or Big Blue Button. Teachers will share which platform and the link via their Canvas course and email to students/parents.</p>
