K, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th Creative Music Activities:

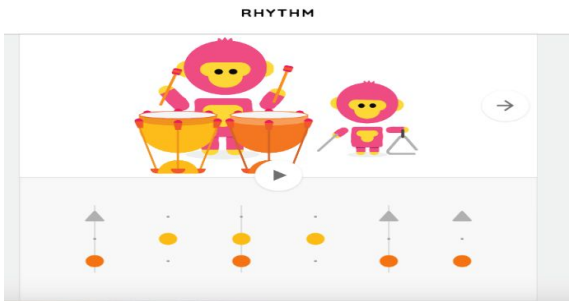
- Draw & color a picture of your favorite instrument.
- Create sound effects to add to your favorite story. Read the story along with the sound effects you created.
- Dance to your favorite song!
- Draw 4 milk jugs and 4 apples. Cut them out. Create 3 different patterns with them. Remember: milk = 1 syllable (ta), apple = 2 syllables (titi). Ta (J) and titi (♩) are our music rhythms! Read each pattern twice & then clap each pattern 3 times. Practice drawing J and ♩.
- Draw a picture of an instrument you imagine. Give it a name and tell someone what it sounds like.
- Draw a picture of 4 things you see outside. Clap their syllables. Sing them in a high voice 3 times. Sing them in a low voice 3 times.

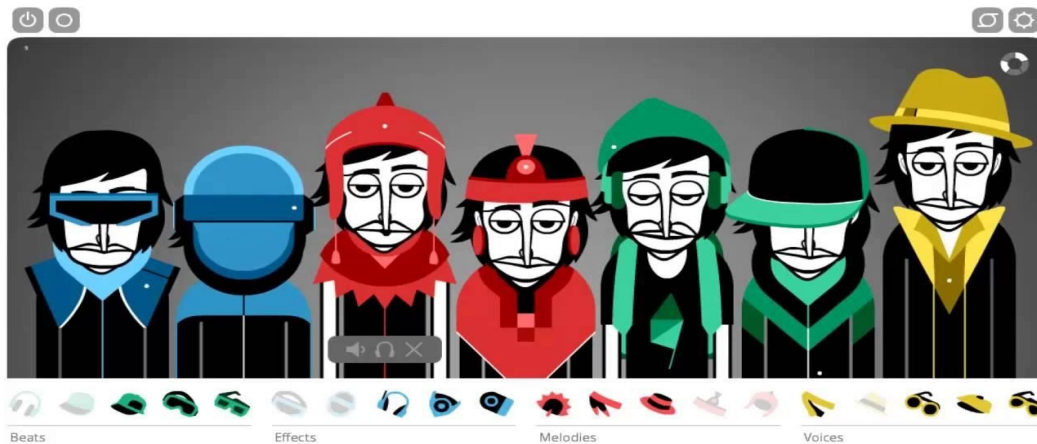

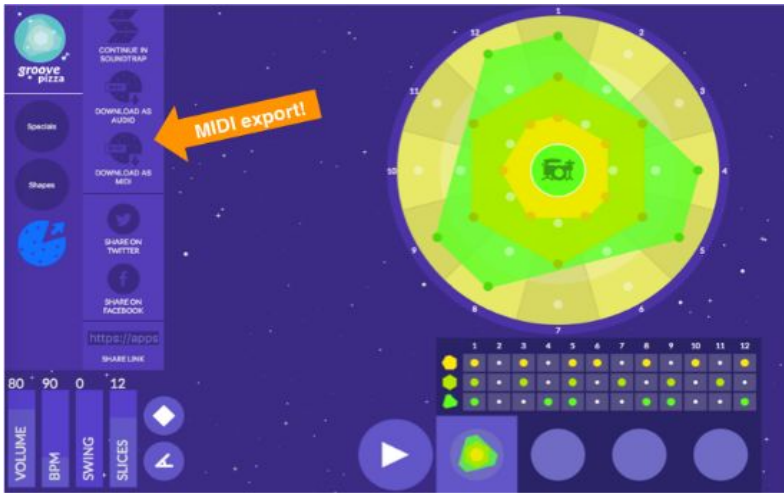
