

Good afternoon parents/guardians of Jennings CLC students,

This letter is to inform you about Jennings status as a Title One Funded Building. Jennings CLC receives federal funding under Title One to provide support to your students. Title One funds support the education system at Jennings CLC in many ways. These funds pay for additional teachers, support staff, and tutors in the building; they provide academic awards and classroom supplies to be given to students. Title One funds pay for teacher professional development and allow the building to host family engagement nights to provide support to parents along with students. Jennings CLC receives these funds due to our academic performance in State Assessments (OSTs).

Because of these funds Jennings has access to curriculum to enrich your students' learning and provide multiple opportunities to develop as a lifelong learner. These curriculums include:

- **MATH**-Comprehensive Math Curriculum, powerful best practices in teaching and easy to use technology to allow personalized instruction effectively- **Savvas's Realize (Envision)**
- **LANGUAGE ARTS**- Rigorous ELA curriculum prepares students for high stakes tests, graduation requirements, and college placement exams- **COLLECTIONS SERIES**
- **SOCIAL STUDIES**- Technology Toolkit integrates technology and literacy standards into the APS SS Core Curriculum of Regions and People of The Eastern Hemisphere, World Studies from Ancient Greece to the First Global Age, United States Exploration Through Reconstruction with a focus on integration into a 1:World Classroom environment. **TCI**
- **SCIENCE**- District Science Fair, Lab-aids, Fusion, SEP-Up, New McGraw-Hill, Zip to Stem partnership with University of Akron. **HMH**
- Common Core Classes Based on Ohio's Educational State Standards, Focuses on 21st Century Learning, 1:World, Prepares your child for College and/or Career, Speciality classes include Gateway to Technology, Includes Personal Wellness and Development / Family and Consumer Sciences, Intervention, Media and Instructional Specialists on hand to support teaching, learning, and assessment.

Since we have these advanced curriculums, Jennings conducts academic assessments to prove student proficiency in their classes. These assessments include:

- Teacher made assessments
- Exact Path (Edmentum) diagnostics to help give students stronger foundational skills in Math and ELA, which is tested three (3) times a year: Fall (September), Winter (December), and Spring (May)
- Jennings also used District Assessment Project (DAP) testing to measure student growth twice a year: Fall (September) and Winter (December)
- Students normally take the Ohio State Test (OST) in Math, Language Arts, and 8th grade Science.
