**Important things you need to know...**  
For the week of 9/2/2019



Hello Families of Betty Jane CLC, this is Ms. Lucas, Principal at Betty Jane CLC, and Mrs. Schmidt, Dean of Students.

Here are your important things to know for the week of September 2, 2019.

1. There is no school on Monday, September 2nd, in observance of Labor Day.
2. Tuesday, September 3rd, is the first day for kindergarten students. Parents of kindergarten students only, may escort their children to class. After the first day of school we ask all parents to help children gain independence by reporting to class on their own. If your child is eating breakfast at school, he/she should report to school **no earlier** than 7:50. Students who are not eating breakfast may report to school between 8:00 and 8:25. Students may enter their classrooms at 8:15, so 8:15 is my recommendation for a drop off time if your child doesn't want to eat breakfast at school.
3. The United Way is donating backpacks and supplies to all Betty Jane students again this school year. Students will be coming home with their backpacks on Wednesday, September 4th. We are grateful for their continued support!
4. Thursday, September 5th is our school safety drill day. We will be conducting fire drills and various other safety drills on this morning. If you are calling or visiting the building this morning, please be patient if we are in the middle of a drill.
5. Friday, September 6th, is school picture day. Students are not required to wear uniforms on this day. Picture order forms were sent home with students this week. Kindergarten students should be receiving their forms on the first day of school.
