Chromebooks

• Access to Chromebooks will be essential during the next few weeks. Most Glover students should have their Chromebooks. If you have a locked chromebook, this may have been a technical error, please bring the Chromebook to the nearest high school for repair. If you did not pick up your Chromebook at Glover it should have been delivered to you soon. Please make sure your child charges their Chromebook everyday so they are prepared for their online assignments each day.

• Contacting Teachers, Counselors, Tutors, Intervention Specialists

On the Glover website page there is information on how to contact your child's teacher, counselor, tutor, or intervention specialist. It also lists the office hours when you can directly get in contact. Please use Remind or Class Dojo or email or texting if you need to reach a Glover staff member. The teachers will be reaching out to you at least once a week but please do not hesitate to contact them with any questions or concerns.

• APS Food Services:

• Pickup for food will be Monday through Thursday at the main entrance from 9:30-11:30 a.m.

- Students will receive "To Go" bags for breakfast and lunch every day, and on Thursdays they
 will be given extra meals to cover Friday. The Chapel will be providing Bags of Love on
 Fridays during the same time frame. The Chapel will be providing Bags of Love on
 Good Friday as usual.
- Meals will be available at any community school (does not have to be assigned school) with the exception of Ott, Essex, Stewart, Early College, NIHF STEM, STEM HS, I PROMISE or Miller South. Meals are available to all children ages 1-18, regardless of the school they attend.
- During Spring break (April 10 17) there will be NO food service at the schools. Posted on the APS website will be locations across the city where food will be distributed.

• Instruction and Curriculum:

- O APS Connected Learning is now online (https://sites.google.com/apslearns.org/extendedbreakresources/home). APS Connected Learning lessons for students for home are posted on akronschools.com. Click on the image APS Connected Learning in the middle of the page to find lessons for this week. These lessons will automatically show up on your child's Chromebook when the device is turned on and connected to the internet. We understand that not all students have access to the internet, so we also have paper/pencil instructional materials available during meal pick up times..
- Starting Monday, March 30th, students will have required work posted in their Google classrooms from their assigned teachers. Please have your children check their emails and Google classrooms for more information from their teachers. Students should be completing their I-Ready Math and Reading assignments each day (45 minutes a week in Math and 45 minutes a week in Reading). Beginning March 30 or sooner your child's teacher will begin posting digital lessons for their students. The current student site on student Chromebooks will be replaced with new information about how your child will connect in Google Classrooms, check emails or use Google Meets to join teachers in real time. Watch the videos along with your student. A family site is also now posted on our Akron Public Schools website with information you need to know in order to help your students. Students are responsible for completing their I-Ready lessons in Math and Reading AND their Google Classroom assignments from their teachers each week. We have students that are completing their I-Ready lessons but are not completing the Google Classroom assignments from their teachers. These assignments are being graded and will count for your child's fourth quarter grades.
