- Free breakfast/lunch and free school supplies distribution
- All students receive a free Chromebook
- eSchool Plus Home Access Center — An online system that provides information for parents
- SMART Board® technology incorporated in classrooms
- Campus includes gymnasium, media center, a designated playground for kindergarten students and more
- Nurse on site
- Academic support programs, including Akron After School and Seeds of Change
- Girls on the Run program — Teaches girls life skills through interactive lessons and running games
- Clubs and programs to encourage student involvement, including Boy Scouts and band
- Helen Arnold Leadership Team (H.A.L.T.) — Made up of students in grades 5 and 6 that assist with greeting guests, helping with school tours and mediating conflicts when necessary
- Community support through partnerships with Mount Calvary Lodge, 100 Black Men of Greater Akron, Inc. and more
- Fun and educational field trips
- Basketball and track programs
- Weekly instruction in music and art by a licensed music and art teacher
- Grade 5 students participate in beginning instrumental instruction
- Full-time licensed art and music therapists on site
- Essential Experiences — With funding from the GAR Foundation, all K – 5 students participate in a meaningful, co-curricular experience outside the classroom
