Dear Families,

On behalf of the staff at Forsyth Middle School, I am excited to welcome you to the 2022-2023 school year. We hope you are enjoying summer and anticipating the start of a new and exciting year. I feel both honored and privileged to be your principal and to work with our highly qualified and dedicated staff, our wonderful students, and all of the supportive parents and community members that make our school great. At FMS, we are committed to keeping student achievement and individual growth our highest priorities. With this, we are also committed to partnering with you, offering a well-rounded education, developing character, and providing engaging academic challenges for all FMS students. I encourage you to carefully read over this letter and feel free to contact us with any questions.

First, we are very pleased with the success of our technology initiative that provides all students in grades 5-12 access to a district laptop. Students may use this laptop for the entire school year once the technology agreement has been signed and the minimal laptop fee has been paid. Parents may stop by school August 4th or August 9th from 8:30 am – 6:30 pm or any day August 2nd to August 11th from 8:30 am to 2:30 pm to sign the laptop agreement, pay the laptop fee, and pick up your child's laptop and back to school information.

In addition, we would like to share some beginning of year information that will be helpful for you and your child as they begin this school year.

- **October 24 (8:00 am – 12:00 pm) & Oct. 27 (3:45 pm – 7:30 pm) – Parent Teacher Conferences, you will call the office at the end of September to schedule**

SCHOOL TO PARENT COMMUNICATION:

FMS is committed to maintaining effective communication and providing our student's families with the information they need to keep their students on track and growing. We encourage both students and guardians to keep current with upcoming events and activities by regularly checking our website at forsythpanthers.org. Also, take advantage of opportunities such as parent-teacher conferences on October 24th and 27th, to touch base with your student's teachers. In addition, FMS has a common conference plan time for each grade level of teachers. Teachers are available to meet with parents in person or on the phone during this time. Sixth and eighth grade plan time is from 8:59-9:49 Tuesday-Friday and fifth and seventh grade level plan time is from 8:05-8:55 Tuesday-Friday. Another way to contact teachers is through email. Please be aware of the following options available to get quick student information:

- Get connected with our online grade book, Tyler SIS 360. This is a great way for you to stay up-to-date with attendance, discipline, lunch balance, missing assignments, and your child's academic progress. You can contact the office for login information.

- If your child is missing an assignment, you will receive an automated call from the school on Tuesday each week. Log into SIS, visit with your child, and review the Schoology calendar with them.

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL:

District-wide, all students will start the 2022-2023 school year on Tuesday, August 23rd. All students (5th through 8th grade) upon arrival to school will go to their homeroom class. Students may drop their items off in their homeroom and then they may go to the cafeteria for breakfast. Students will need to return to their homeroom when they finish eating breakfast. Students will remain in their homeroom classroom until the bell rings to head to first hour class. The tardy bell for first hour rings at 8:05 am. The first few days, teachers will be getting students familiar with this procedure as well as helping students with directions, lockers, bathrooms, getting to lunch, and finding their buses at the end of the day. If you bring or pick up your child, you will drop them off and pick them up in front of the middle school building. First period will begin at 8:05 am; students are not allowed into the building until 7:40 am. School ends at 3:25 pm. Students are expected to ride the bus, walk home, attend Boys and Girls Club or get picked up, unless they have a note from a parent or legal guardian changing their normal routine. If students are going to another student's house, we need a note from the guardian of each student before a bus pass will be issued.
