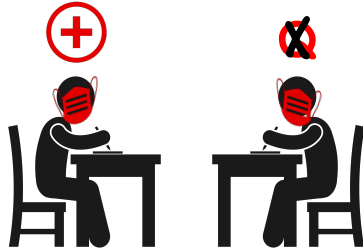


HOW IS QUARANTINE DETERMINED?



Student Tests Positive

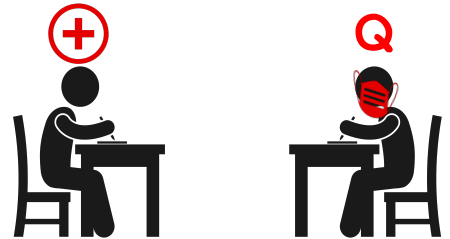
Contact Tracing: Contact tracing is done to determine who was within 6 feet of the person who tested positive for 15 minutes or longer.



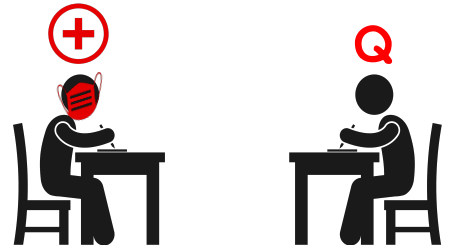
Masks: If the student who tested positive and the students who were within 3- 6 feet were wearing masks consistently and correctly, the students who were exposed do not have to quarantine.



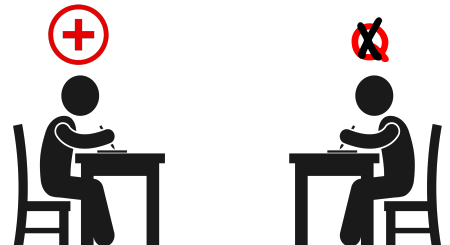
No Mask: If the student who tested positive is not wearing a mask, all students within 6 feet for 15 minutes or longer are required to quarantine.



No Mask: If a student was within 6 feet for 15 minutes or longer to a masked student who tested positive and was not wearing a mask, he/she is required to quarantine.



Vaccinated: If students are vaccinated, they are not required to quarantine when exposed to a student who tested positive.



A student can test on or after day 5 of quarantine. With documentation of a negative test result, students can return to school on day 8.



Staff

- If staff are in close contact with a masked or unmasked positive individual and are unvaccinated, they must quarantine.
