HOW TO BECOME A SECONDARY TEACHER

PREREQUISITES

- Content Area Coursework
 - **English:** 30 credits in English major
 - **French:** 30 credits in French major
 - **Spanish:** 30 credits in Spanish major
 - **Mathematics:** 30 credits in math major
 - **Social studies:** 30 credits in history, economics, political science, geography, sociology or anthropology major
 - **Science:** 30 credits in physics, biology, geology or chemistry major
- Three years of studying a language in high school, or one semester of studying a language in college.
- Transcript review with TLEL

HOW TO BECOME AN ELEMENTARY TEACHER

PREREQUISITES

- Coursework
 - Two undergraduate courses in English with a C+ or better
 - Two undergraduate courses in natural science with a C+ or better
 - Two undergraduate courses in social studies with a C+ or better
 - Two undergraduate courses in math with a C+ or better
 - A liberal arts and sciences concentration
- Three years of studying a language in high school, or one semester of studying a language in college.
- Transcript review with TLEL

- Two letters of recommendation
