The Binghamton City School District Board of Education continues to consider options for the long-term future of our school facilities. The feasibility study began last summer and included input from stakeholders throughout the process. We anticipate sharing an update on the feasibility study at our board meeting on Tues., June 14. Our priority is to remain fiscally responsible, while providing the most efficient programming, opportunities and facilities for our students and community.

Data shows that population and student enrollment is declining in Binghamton, Broome County and across New York State. The district's goal is to maintain effective class sizes. Several scenarios are being considered by the board, which may result in the rebuilding, repurposing, and/or closing of one or more school buildings. It is important to understand that changes in a district of our size could take 2-5 years to implement. Any plan to do so would be widely and transparently shared with the school community.
