Action Item	Responsibility	Completion and Deployment
Include more parents and students on district safety teams.	District and BHS Safety Teams will ask for high school students to serve on the district and school safety teams.	By March 1 st , the district safety teams will have identified 4 students to serve on each team. Bi-annual meetings with student representatives will be held to listen to safety concerns, which will inform building and community practices.
Establish better protocols for evacuations to multiple evacuation sites and increase training of students around protocols and include a means of communication to students during an evacuation or Lock Out.	BHS Safety Team will identify two additional evacuation sites and develop a protocol for their use during an evacuation.	By March 1 st , two additional sites will be identified, protocols shared with faculty and students, and each site will be used to practice the drills with students.

<p>Work with Binghamton PD to ensure there is a presence in neighborhoods surrounding BHS.</p>	<p>Building and District Leadership will meet with the Chief of Police and identify a plan for increased safety in the surrounding neighborhoods. This plan will be communicated to BHS families.</p>	<p>BPD is preparing a Safety Audit that will be shared with the District in February. The District will create a schedule by March 1 to implement proposed recommendations.</p>
