

## BHS Summer School 2022 (Algebra and Geometry)

### Welcome Message:

For those who don't know me, my name is Ms. Reed. I teach math at BHS for the past 16 years. I will be your 'guide' for math summer school classes using the educational platform called Edgenuity.

Edgenuity has built in lessons, activities and labs that allow you to work at your own pace and provides the opportunity to skip lessons if you have prior knowledge mastery. This will save time and skip you ahead in your lessons, so take the pre-lesson assessments seriously.

Sometimes you might hit a "roadblock", don't worry - I may need to reset or open activities for you. It is very important that you "check in" by zoom and/or email - to keep good communication. I will be available on Zoom, Monday - Thursday, 10 am - 1 pm and will check my emails regularly to make sure you are on track. I'm making myself very accessible to help you, so please take advantage!

**Putting time in daily is VERY IMPORTANT.** Do your best, ask questions, and let me help you achieve your credit goal for your math class. I've used Edgenuity in the past and I can help you navigate through your math course(s). This is a great opportunity to complete a 40 week course in 5 weeks! If you work ahead, you can complete course work early. **You just need to put the time and effort in daily.**

I'm also enrolling everyone in a **Summer School Math Google Classroom**, so we can have good communication and provide you with easy access to Edgenuity login/ information and other helpful materials. You can leave messages in the class stream if you need help. I will add each one of you, but here are the class codes if you were not entered.

### Tips to be Successful in BHS Virtual Summer School

1. Check in Monday to Thursday during the 10 - 1 PM. You can work independently in the Zoom link or you can check in with me any time during that 3 hour Zoom. You are not expected to stay for any set amount of time, but I will be there to help you.
2. Make sure you put in 1 hour of work daily - start out strong. The more time you put in, the faster you complete the course. You can complete course work ANYTIME, not just during the 10 am - 1 pm Monday to Thursday. You can break up your 1 hour into smaller chunks. Any time or activity - gets you closer to your goal.
3. Don't get discouraged. I'm here to help and will help you as many times as you need. So please don't be afraid to ask for help. This is a great opportunity for you to complete a class in 5 weeks!
