 - 38:1 mental health ratio
 - Eric mentioned that this is an important factor for success

 - She is an academic counselor
 - She is our School Assessment Coordinator- SAT/CMASS
 - Music - Jeffrey Collins
 - From San Diego
 - The students are connecting very well
- **Safety/Security Update**
 - Report on Community -
 - Security Specialist - Rachel Brekke
 - Rachel: first week no issues
 - Officer Ted Bathauer - LTPD
 - Hoping to have full time SRO, but he will be here 2-4 hours/week.
He will do the best he can

- Call for service last week. Another officer responded. They will try diversion
 - Try to connect students with appropriate services to help
- **Eagle Updates:**
 - Eagle posted a 96% graduation rate last school year
 - Mission and Vision Statement changes
 - We rewrote both. Align to how Eagle has changed and with District initiative
 - Year 4. Wanted to build our arts and theater- creativity is valued
 - Growth mindset goals for each teacher. Confidence, determination and grit
 - Vision always around the family model- relational
 - Field Trips - Miller Outdoor Park - Sept 12
 - Asked for approval for funds from budget to provide
 - Per SAC, funds are okayed
 - We have experience and food trucks for the kids
 - Takeaways are impactful
 - SAT/PSAT - Alternative Ed scores released later this month
 - Scores not released for Alt Ed. Will provide next meeting
 - ASVAB
 - 2x per year- fall and spring
 - Benchmark cut score, counts as a graduation requirement. Need 31 or higher
 - Military will administer
 - Another opportunity
 - Capstone
 - They are working on achieving
- **School Goals for 2019-20**
 - CAS
 - Teacher goals to transition to CAS. Our PD is around implementation
 - Growth Mindset
 - It will vary depending on where the teacher is in our school

 - It is an accountability measure for growth and achievement
