1.0 RATIONALE

- 1.1 Bluewater District School Board policies will support and provide direction necessary to achieve the board’s Vision, Mission, and Strategic Plan priorities.
- 1.2 In the event of a nuclear emergency at the Bruce Power Site it is necessary to have a co-ordinated response to the situation in partnership with the Municipality of Kincardine Emergency Response Organization. The safety of students and staff is of utmost concern to Bluewater District School Board.

2.0 POLICY

- 2.1 Bluewater District School Board will participate as requested in any exercises (real or staged) conducted by the Municipality of Kincardine Emergency Response Organization as it relates to the Bruce Power Site.
- 2.2 In the event of a nuclear emergency at the Bruce Power site Bluewater District School Board will abide by the expectations of this policy and follow the procedures outlined in related Administrative Procedure AP 2805-D “Emergency Plan – Bruce Nuclear Generating Station (Bruce Power)”.
- 2.3 Permission is granted for the use of parking lots, classrooms, auditoriums, libraries, and washroom facilities at Bluewater District School Board schools on a short-term basis in the event of a nuclear emergency, as identified in the Municipality of Kincardine Emergency Response Plan. Authorization is to be provided by the director of education.
