Dear Parents/Guardians:

As promised previously by the Minister of Education and in my ongoing communications, all secondary students have received a final semester two report card. This report card represents your child's progress, learning skills, and work habits between February 3, 2020 and June 26, 2020. This period includes the provincially-mandated school closure period from March 14, 2020 to June 30, 2020. Your child's final course mark is the grade they had prior to school closures or higher, if additional work was completed that improved their grade after March 13, 2020.

Report cards provide valuable information to students and their families regarding each student's progress and staff have worked under very unusual circumstances to provide as much useful information as possible. During the closure period, we recognize that access to learning supports and opportunities, and extra help have been uneven and very different than when your child was in a classroom setting. For this reason, this report card may look differently than in previous years. Every attempt was made to provide enough feedback for you and your child to understand their progress at the end of this unprecedented school year.
