Resolution 20-2 Support for Governor Evers Budget Surplus Plan
February 19, 2020

Whereas, the school board, administrators, teachers, staff, parents and community members of the School District of South Milwaukee are united in our effort to provide all children with the highest quality educational opportunities possible; and

Whereas, Governor Evers called on the Wisconsin Legislature to hold a special session to consider investing part of the budget surplus in schools and taxpayers; and

Whereas, under the bill \$130 million would be appropriated to equalization aid which will reduce local property tax levies in 2020-21; and


Whereas, under the bill \$79.1 million would be appropriated to special education categorical aid for 2020-21 which would result in an estimated \$266,170 in additional spendable revenue for South Milwaukee; and

Whereas, under the bill investments in school mental health programs, and other school-based mental health service will be made; and


Whereas, under the bill investments will be made that impact rural and urban schools; and


Therefore, the School District of South Milwaukee School Board resolves to express its support of Governor Evers proposal for K-12 education and property tax relief:


