- Supervising children and infants.
- Performing basic child-care skills such as diapering, feeding, and dressing.

- Handling bedtime and discipline issues.
- Identifying safety hazards and preventing injuries.
- Caring for common injuries such as burns, cuts, and bee stings.
- Communicating effectively with parents.
- Finding and interviewing for babysitting jobs.
