## **HUNTER EDUCATION COURSE REQUIREMENTS**

Anyone born on or after Jan. 1, 1973, must complete a hunter education course and have a hunter education safety certificate on file to purchase any hunting license in Wisconsin. The hunter education course instills in students the knowledge and skill to be responsible and safe hunters. The course consists of 10 lessons for a minimum of 10 hours.

Students learn how hunting accidents are caused and how they can be prevented. Hunter's responsibility and safety are stressed throughout the classes, which consist of lectures, demonstrations, group discussions, practical exercises, and individual study and activity assignments.
